McKinley T34™Syringe Driver

This course aims to provide registered nurses with the knowledge, skills and confidence required to manage, monitor and ensure safe administration of medicines via the continuous subcutaneous infusion route.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- To be able to list the reasons for set up and the advantages and disadvantages for using syringe drivers
- To review knowledge of the McKinley T34[™] syringe driver, including safety features, care and maintenance checks
- To discuss professional accountability and responsibility, including correct documentation and procedures for set up, regular checks and discontinuation
- To know the commonly used drugs, to be able to complete calculations and refresh medicines for end-of-life care
- To be able to select and assess sites for cannulation
- To gain confidence and to critically evaluate good practice procedures

- Self-Assessment of competency will be discussed during training and will be emailed to participants for their completion to provide evidence to their line manager/clinical lead
- It is advised that organisations provide the trainer with a copy of their policy and procedure prior to the training
