Understanding Oxygen Therapy, Respiration, Nebuliser and Inhalers

This half day course is designed to teach the candidate the correct, safe way to administer nebulisers and inhalers and oxygen to the individual and equip them with the basic knowledge and confidence to be able to use this skill within the workplace.

- To gain an understanding of the anatomy and actions of the respiratory system
- To gain knowledge on how and why oxygen therapy is necessary
- To be able to administer prescribed oxygen safely, (use of equipment and cleaning procedures)
- To be able to administer nebulisers and inhalers competently
- To understand the importance of maintaining skin integrity
- To fully understand accountabilities & responsibilities including documentation, risk assessments and all safety checks
