Verification of Expected Adult Death

This course is suitable for all nurses and senior care staff (who would like to take on the extended role of verification of expected adult death). The session aims to enable participants to have the confidence, knowledge, skills, qualities and competencies necessary to correctly verify expected adult death and care after death.

- Understand role and accountabilities in verification of expected adult death and the responsibilities and conditions required (organisational, national and local policies)
- Identify the circumstances when it would be appropriate to verify death
- Differentiate between recognition, verification, registration and certification
- Outline the differences between expected death and other patterns of dying
- List the accepted clinical signs of death
- Understand the procedures for care after death
- Identify the correct documentation and notification requirements to support and evidence safe and effective practice
